CS1V Console Channel



Overview

CS1V brings the warmth and depth of an analogue console to your tracks and mixes. Drive increases the level of saturation. Tone adjusts pre-amp character; darker and heavier in the low range anti-clockwise, and progressively brighter high end harmonic boost clockwise. There are two selectable preamp modes: A is darker in character overall, while B has a flatter frequency response. The default "Channel" mode is intended for mono tracks. When inserted on stereo tracks or auxes, the "Buss" setting can be used to add a subtle amount of crosstalk, as in a



Controls

Channel/Buss:	Channel is for mono tracks, Buss for stereo - adds simulated crosstalk.
Group:	Sets the group number 1 -8.
∅:	Phase switch.
Mode:	Frequency response mode, A - darker, B - flatter.
Drive:	Sets input gain level.
Tone:	Sets overall tone characteristics.
AGC:	Auto makeup for output level.
Bypass:	Bypasses processing.
i:	Version and registration information.

Grouping

Group mode allows all instances of CS1V in your session to be controlled from any one instance of CS1V. For example, setting Drive on any CS1V will update all other instances in the same group (1-8), making it easy to shape the character of your DAW's mixer as a whole. Drive, Tone and bypass can all be controlled as a group.

Installation and Authorizing

Double-click the CS1V installer, and select which formats you wish to install. Without a valid license present the plugin will run in demo mode, and will silence it's output at random intervals. If you have purchased a license, login to the user area of our site, with the user and password you were emailed. You will see a list of all available licenses. Download and unzip the license file and place it in the Mellowmuse "Licenses" folder. This folder is created for you by the installer in the following location:

Windows: /Program Files/Mellowmuse/Licenses

Macintosh: /Library/Application Support/Mellowmuse/Licenses

System Requirements

Mac: OSX 10.4 or higher with PPC or Intel processor.

Windows: XP SP2, Vista or Windows 7.

Hosts: Pro Tools v7.4 or above, or a Audio Unit/VST 2.4 compatible host.

Formats: RTAS, VST, Audio Unit, all available as both 32 and 64-bit binaries.
